Course Description

This class is almost exclusively “hands on” behind the wheel training involving emergency driving techniques with an emphasis on vehicle control, controlled braking, backing up, off-road recovery, skids, crash evasion and defensive driving.

Course Objectives

Through this course students will gain a better understanding and learn skills in the following emergency driving situations:

- ✓ Serpentine (*controlled slalom and vehicle handling*)
- ✓ Controlled braking
- ✓ Backing skill development
- ✓ Emergency off-road recovery
- ✓ Skid situations
- ✓ Evasive techniques to avoid a traffic crash
- ✓ Good defensive driving techniques

Instructor

Dan Shannon, Safety and Health Specialist with SIU, having over 35 years of experience in this training field, will be Lead Instructor. Dan will be assisted by members of his SIU *Emergency and Evasive Vehicle Operation Course Staff*.
Dan is an "Approved Instructor" by the State Training Board for "EEVOC".

Officers attending this training must come with a department owned Patrol Vehicle in safe operating condition. There should one police vehicle per student. All “spin-out” and “recovery” maneuver driver training will be conducted with vehicles provided by the SIU Safety Center.
