### Course Description

You will learn the nuts and bolts of creating a *No-Refusal Program* in your jurisdiction and will be taught the ins and outs of the process, including who to involve. You will also have a practical session where you will create your own *Complaint and Search Warrant*. Additionally, you will learn what steps to take if the offender persists in the refusal after a search warrant is obtained. You will also receive a DUI Case Law Update.

- How to create a Complaint and Search Warrant specific to DUI evidence.
- Proper steps for persistent offender refusal after search warrant has been obtained.
