An <u>MTU 15 Course Enrollment Form</u> and a copy of the officer's "Form E" <u>must</u> be received by MTU 15 for enrollment in this class no later than one week prior to the start of the class.</p> <p>All weapons and ammunition will be inspected on the first day of this class. If significant malfunctions occur, which the Lead Instructor determines are caused by a faulty weapon or ammunition, the student will be required to replace the defective gun, or ammunition, before continuing with the class. It is <u>strongly</u> recommended that officers train and qualify with the handgun that they will carry on duty.</p>
