This presentation will use the Search & Seizure Case Digest. Topics include the latest Illinois and Federal cases dealing with Search & Seizure with specific topics to include:

- Questioning during and after traffic stops
- Drug dog use
- Wants & Warrants checks
- Consent searches
- Probationer searches
- Searches of Vehicles
- Exigent circumstances searches
- Requirements for obtaining warrants pursuant to Article 108 and overhears pursuant to Articles 108A and 108B of the Code of Criminal Procedure
- Requirements for warrants created by the Freedom from Drone Surveillance Act (725 ILCS 167/)
- Requirements for warrants created by Freedom from Location Surveillance Act (725 ILCS 168/).
