Note: All weapons and ammunition will be inspected on the first day of this class. If significant malfunctions occur, which the Lead instructor determines are caused by a faulty weapon or ammunition, the student will be required to replace the defective gun, or ammunition, before continuing with the class. It is strongly recommended that officers train and qualify with the handgun that they will carry on duty.
