Course Description

This training is intended to provide the investigator with an understanding of the importance of, and how to properly conduct, a covert surveillance operation to collect evidence for a criminal investigation.

Course Objectives

- Explain the purpose and methods of basic surveillance operations
- Explain the phases of surveillance
- Demonstrate the planning and preparation of a surveillance operation
- Demonstrate the post-operations reporting of a surveillance operation
- Conduct a practical field exercise
- Have a working understanding of Illinois Eavesdropping law (720 ILCS 5/14-1)

Instructor

Illinois State Police Commander Derek Wise will be the instructor. Lt. Wise has served as a municipal police officer and with the Illinois State Police having risen to the position of Zone Commander.
