Course Description

Illinois 95th General Assembly Resolution 0051 requires *Manufacturer's* Certification on Elector-Muscular Disruption Technology (EMDT) Employed by Illinois law Enforcement and Correctional Officers. TASER International requires that users of the TASER Conducted Electrical Weapon (CEW) device take a certification course prior to carrying the TASER. That certification expires one year from the date of issue.

This 4 hour class is for the re-certification of those officers who have previously received the full 8 hour TASER Conducted Energy Weapon Certification class. This re-certification will involve a review of TASER technology and the proper and safe methods for deployment of the TASER EMD device. "Failure Drills" will be practiced and a written examination will be given, as a part of this re-certification process. Officers attending this class must have been certified or re-certified within the past 12 months.

Course Objectives

- Understand how the TASER overrides and controls the central nervous system of a combative subject.
- Know proper aiming and deployment of the TASER *CEW*.
- Reload in a safe and proper manner.
- Recognize when the TASER is armed and ready to deploy.
- Know how to install batteries.
- Proper utilization of the laser sight.
- Understand probe placement ballistics.
- Constitutional issues and case law on Use-of-Force and "Intermediate Weapons".

Geoff is certified by TASER International as a TASER CEW Device Instructor.
