Course Description				
<p>MACTAC is the swift and immediate deployment of law enforcement resources to an active threat/terrorist attack, which may include multiple, simultaneous attacks. These situations require immediate action and the rapid deployment of patrol officers. Failure to act could have catastrophic consequences resulting in death and/or great bodily harm to innocent people. These incidents may also necessitate the immediate and rapid deployment of patrol personnel to contain and prevent the escape of an armed and dangerous offender, or rescue a downed officer and/or civilian. This two-day, 16-hour course is designed to teach officers the Multiple Assault Counter Terrorist Action Capabilities (MACTAC) course curriculum. The focus of this program will be to provide officers with the knowledge, specialized tactical skills, and associated printed materials they will need to become familiar with and perform MACTAC / urban tactic skill sets.</p>
